

## **Biography of Eduardo Rodriguez**

**Eduardo Rodriguez** is a senior partner in Rodriguez, Colvin, Chaney and Saenz, L.L.P. in Brownsville. A lawyer in general practice, Rodriguez served on the State Bar of Texas Board of Directors from 1987 to 1990.
